Prof . S. N. Ratha is a distinguished Sociologist Social Anthropologist of India. Trained under the fostering care of Late Professor A. Aiyappan at the Utkal University, and Professor Cora Du Bois of Harvard University, he has been active in the field of teaching and research nearing half a century, beginning as a Research Scholar from 1961-63 and then as a lecturer at the university of Gauhati in 1963 followed as the founding Professor and Head of the department of Anthropology and Sociology, Sambalpur University, Orissa, from 1976-1996. Professor Ratha, now in his 14th year of retirement from formal service, has been as active as ever in teaching and research. He is in the executive committees of many National and the International Academic bodies including the 'International Union of Anthropological and Ethnological Sciences'. Professor Ratha's research output includes three books and more than a hundred papers and he is the former Professor and Head of the Department of Sociology and Social anthropology, Sambalpur University, Orissa.
